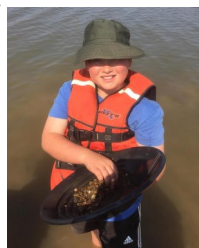

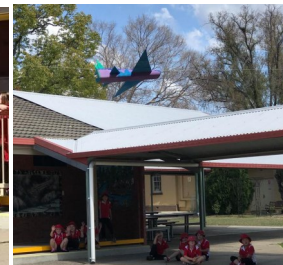

The students in years 5 and 6 that did not attend the excursion spent the week researching, designing and building balsa wood, soda bulb aeroplanes. Students had to research the various parts of a plane and the aerodynamics that enhance a plane's ability to fly smoothly. Students then had to use their research of plane designs to create their own plane that they thought would be aerodynamic. Students were required to plan their plane including measurements and wing placement. Once the students had a solid design they were required to sand back their balsa wood block to create the shape they had designed, draw their wings onto ply and create a coloured version of their plan ready for painting. Students then got to celebrate their plane designs by hosting an Airshow for the rest of the school to come and watch where their soda bulbs were set off and their planes soared along the zip line.







## Spotlight on 4T

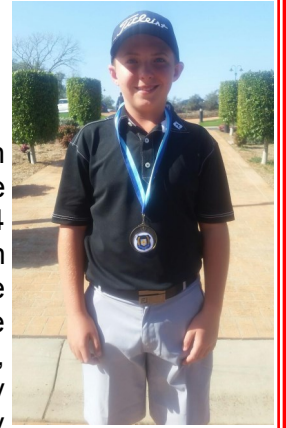
