Parent/Teacher Interviews

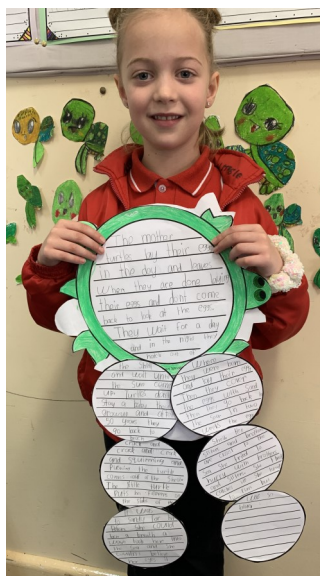

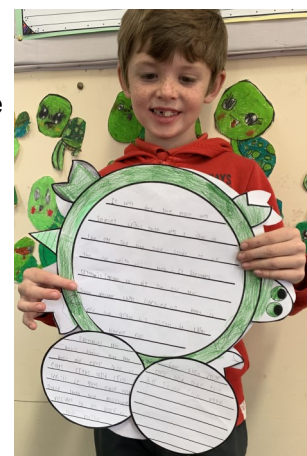
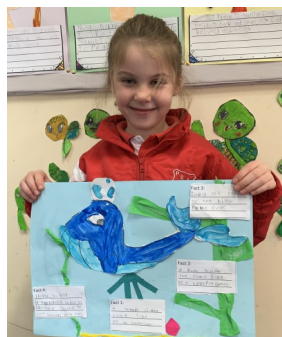
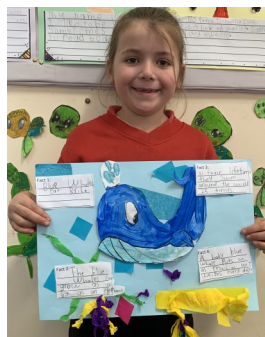




Spotlight on 1E
