The commando course was epic! It didn't matter who was in our groups, we all helped each other. Our favourite parts were walking through the mud and going under the tyres.

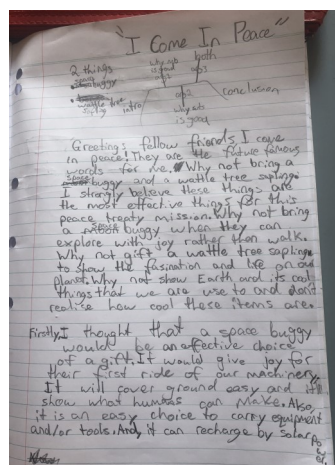
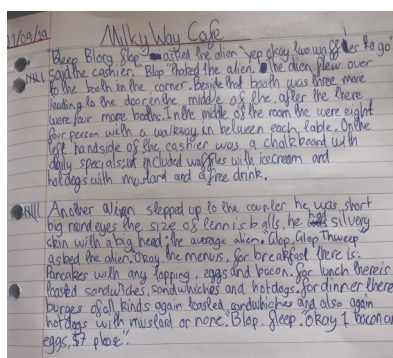
We worked in different teams at night and challenged the teachers.
